Applicant Qualifications and Requirements:

The applicant must be coming into or currently in their senior year of college. The applicant may also be in a graduate student program.

The applicant must be studying any agriculture or natural resources related field for the purpose of returning to a livestock ranch or be closely involved in managing lands for the ranching industry.

An essay of no more than 4 pages is asked to accompany the application to this scholarship. The essay should include: A history about the applicants background related to ranching and/or land management experiences, how their involvement in college has changed their understanding moving forward with ranching and land management, and finally, what the applicant hopes to accomplish after completing their time in college. Examples of leadership experiences and specific goals mentioned will be seen as positive viewpoints during the selection process.

Tavaputs Ranch is honoring the memory of the late Tate Jensen through an annual **\$2,500** scholarship bearing his name through donations received by friends of the Jensen family. A true cowboy, friend, and industry leader was lost with Tate's passing in 2011. Tate was a sixth generation rancher on the Tavaputs Ranch in Southeast Utah. He was an example of the wise use of natural resources, and was a successful surrogate for public land issues which brought he and his family much respect across the west. His dedication to improving the land he lived and worked on with the livestock and rangelands he managed allowed him to be an example to all the people around him. Many people from professors, to outdoor recreationist, to other fellow ranchers and friends remember Tate's powerful and enduring legacy. The purpose of this scholarship is to honor Tate's legacy by awarding an individual who reflects the same values as Tate with of a love of ranching and the lands involved for that industry.
